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PUBLIC AUCTION NOTICE FOR SALE OF UNSERVICEABLE ITEMS

A public sector organization intends to dispose-off following condemned / scrap stores through sealed bidding on "on-as-is-where-is-basis" by 25th August 2025

1. Auction Mode:

The auction will be conducted through *sealed bids* on an "as-is-where-is" basis through EPADS.

2. Auction Lots:

Unserviceable/condemned items will be grouped into complete lots. Partial bids for individual items within a lot will not be accepted.

List of items is available on NIPA Karachi's website (www.nipakarachi.gov.pk)

3. **Inspection of Items**:

Interested bidders may inspect the auction lots at the designated NIPA Karachi location on 13th August 2025 between 10:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Only individuals cleared by security staff upon showing original CNIC.

4. Submission of Bids:

- Bids must be submitted on EPADS.
- Each bid must be accompanied by a Pay Order/Demand Draft equal to 15% of the bid amount as earnest money, in favor of Director General, NIPA Karachi.
- o The deadline for submission of sealed bids is 11:00 am 25th August, 2025.
- o Bids will be opened on the same day at 11:30 am.

5. Eligibility Criteria:

 Only Active Taxpayers (ATL) are eligible to participate. A copy of ATL status must be attached to the bid form.

6. Opening and Finalization of Bids:

o Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders or their representatives.

- The 15% bid amount submitted by unsuccessful bidders will be refunded after finalization.
- The successful bidder will be required to deposit the remaining 85% amount within 7 working days after approval.

7. Lifting of Auctioned Items:

- The successful bidder must remove the awarded lot(s) within 15 working days after full payment.
- Failure to lift the items within the stipulated time will result in forfeiture of the earnest money, and the lot may be offered to the next highest bidder.

8. No Claim Policy:

- No complaint or claim regarding the condition or completeness of items will be entertained after the bid is finalized.
- o Bidders are encouraged to fully inspect the lots before bidding.

9. Right to Reject:

 NIPA Karachi reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids wholly or partially without assigning any reason as per Rule 33 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

10. Compliance with Rules:

- The auction will be conducted in accordance with Rule 20 of the General Financial Rules (GFR) Vol-I, Government of Pakistan.
- Disposal shall also comply with the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and other relevant instructions issued by the Finance Division.

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
